ROSS' RECIPES

Ross Midgley, a Culinary Arts alum and current Program Manager at The Culinary Institute of Canada, brings more than twenty-five years of culinary expertise to Holland College.

A Red Seal certified chef, he has led kitchens across Ontario, including nearly two decades as an Executive Chef, and honed his craft internationally during a six-month stage at the Michelin-starred Chewton Glen in England. Ross has also shared his knowledge as a sessional instructor at The Good Earth Cooking School, Les Marmitons International, and Niagara College's Canadian Food and Wine Institute.



In this issue, as part of a new regular feature in our newsletter, Chef Ross serves up a comforting, coastal-inspired fish chowder. It's a hearty, soul-warming dish perfect for the cold winter months.

Chef Ross's Fish Chowder

Ingredients

- 4 cups onion, finely diced
- 2 cups carrot, finely diced
- 2 cups celery, finely diced
- 2 cups potatoes, diced
- ¼ cup unsalted butter
- 4 tbsp all-purpose flour
- 1 tbsp ground coriander

- 1 piece double-smoked bacon (about 2 inches)
- 3 cups white wine
- 3 tbsp Pernod
- 8 litres fish stock
- 6 cups diced fresh or smoked fish (salmon and whitefish such as haddock)
- ½ cup 35% cream
- 3 tbsp chopped tarragon
- 3 tbsp chopped dill

Method

1. In a large stock pot, gently sauté the onion, carrot, celery, and potatoes in the butter along with the piece of bacon.
2. After five minutes, dust the mixture with the flour and ground coriander. Stir with a wooden spoon until the vegetables are well coated and the flour becomes sticky.
3. Deglaze with the white wine and Pernod, stirring continuously to form a smooth paste. Add the fish stock.
4. Add the chopped fish and allow the chowder to simmer for 45 minutes.
 - For a smokier flavour, a little julienned smoked salmon can be added.
5. Remove the piece of bacon, then stir in the cream, tarragon, and dill.
6. Serve warm and enjoy.

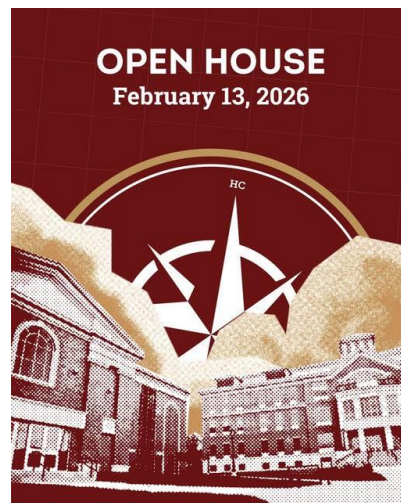

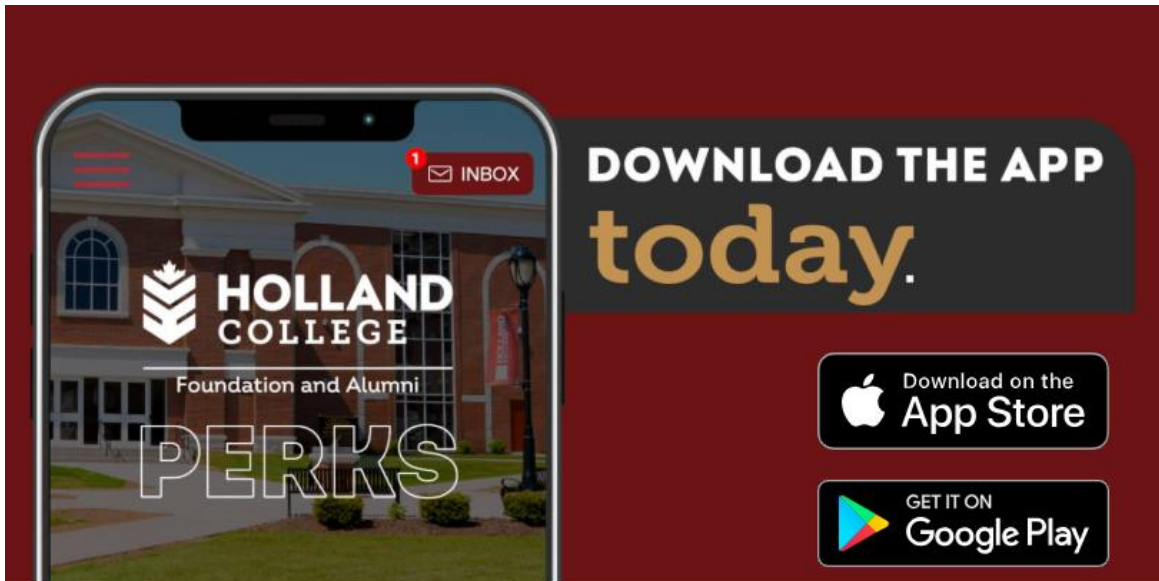

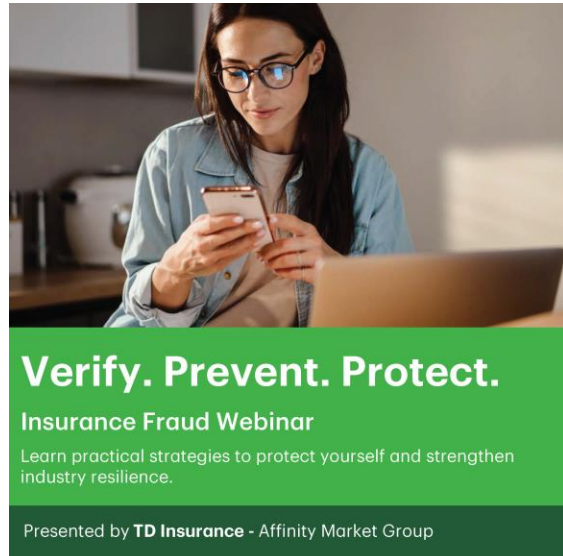
