Last Chance Christmas Craft Fair Policies and Guidelines

As a vendor at the Last Chance Christmas Craft Fair, we appreciate your attention to the terms outlined below. All policies and guidelines are in place to benefit our guests and vendors!

Booth Sizes

- Regular (9' x 9' area, includes one 6' x 30" table)
- Large (9' x 14' area, includes two 6' x 30" tables in preferred location)

Vendor and Entrance Fees

Regular vendor: \$50.00 + HST*Large vendor: \$75.00 + HST*

• Specialty vendor of different size: Please contact

• Entrance Fees: \$2.00 + non-perishable donation to local food bank

Vendors will receive three (3) ID tags for entry. Additional guests are required to pay admission upon entry.

Payments can be made with: cash, cheque, e-transfer, debit, credit. Please select an option on the registration form below.

Booth Electricity and Services

During the registration process, please notify us if you will require power to your booth. Organizers will ensure there is power within 10' of your booth location. Vendors are responsible to have their own extension cords within this distance. For special requests, please contact Mikeal Thomas at 902-439-6992 or by email at mjthomas@hollandcollege.com

Booth Setup and Expectations

- Vendors are expected to maintain an appropriate level of organization at their booth, which includes keeping all items within their allotted space.
- Please refrain from blocking walkways and exits at all times. Product should be kept within the allotted space.
- Vendors are welcome to enter the facility after 12:00 PM on Friday December 13th and must remain set up for the entire duration of the fair. Any requests to vacate the site early must be discussed in advance. Booths must be cleared from the facility by 10:00 PM on December 14th.
- If there are customers meeting you at the Craft Fair to pick up a previously purchased item, you must meet them at the entrance, or they will be required to pay the entry fee to reach your booth.

Other Notes and Policies

- Only one vendor business per booth.
- Booths will be reserved on a first-come first-served basis. As availability lessens, vendor type will be considered in the approval process. Ex: knits, woods, paintings, foods, Arbonne/Scentsy/Avon reps, etc.
- Silent auction and raffle prizes on-site to benefit local food banks. Product donations for auction and raffle are greatly appreciated.
- Canteen on-site in support of the Holland Hurricanes women's hockey team.
