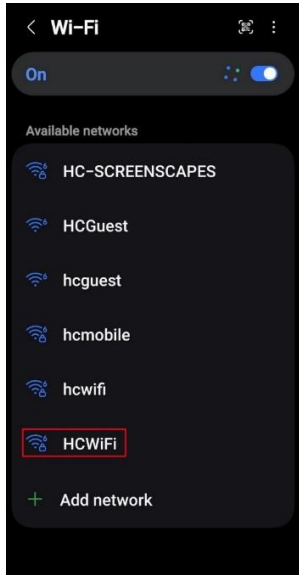
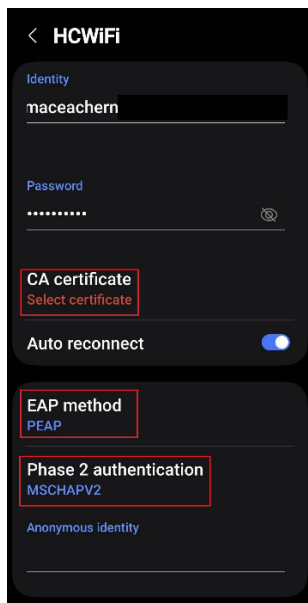


Connecting to HCWiFi with Android

1. Open your Android Wi-Fi utility
2. Select the **HCWiFi** wireless network




3. Leave **EAP method** and **Phase 2 authentication** as their defaults (**PEAP** and **MSCHAPV2** respectively). Under **CA Certificate**, choose "Don't validate".
4. Enter your Holland College username in **Identity** and your password in **Password**, leaving **Anonymous Identity** blank.



5. Click **Connect**

6. You will be taken to a Captive Portal. Select the **checkbox** (which means you agree to the terms of the Acceptable Use Policy) and click **Agree**.
