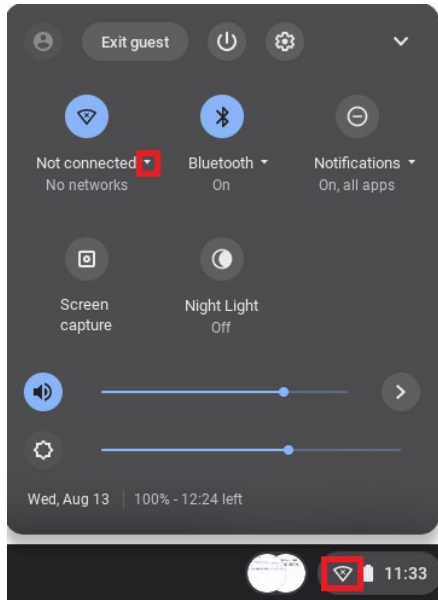
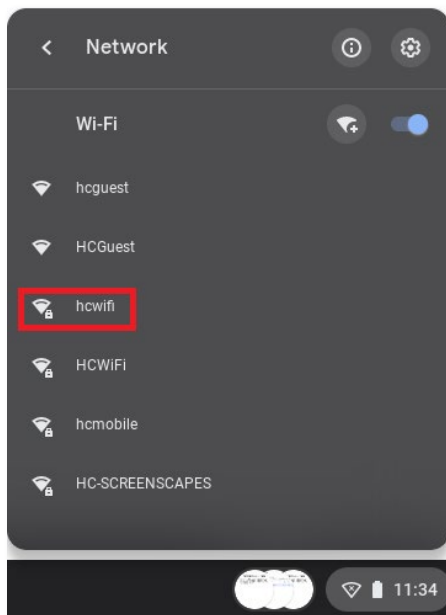


## Connecting to HCWIFI with a Chromebook

1. Click on the ChromeOS wireless utility icon
2. Click on the wireless networks icon in the upper left corner of the window



3. Select the **HCWIFI** wireless network (Will be all caps on your device).



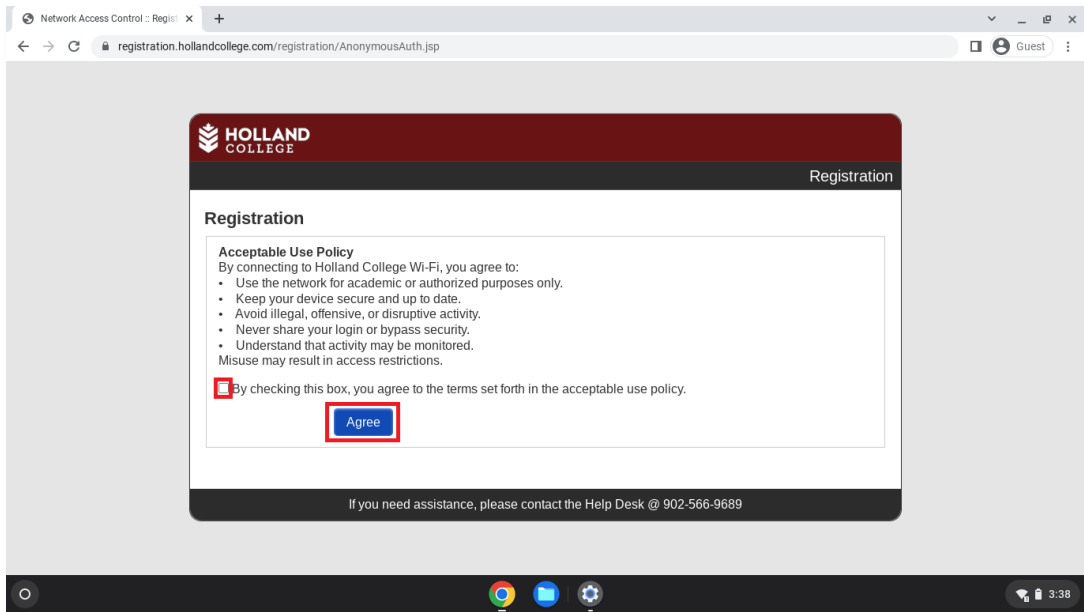
4. Ensure the EAP Method is set to **PEAP** (it will likely default to LEAP). Leave all other settings as default.
